1. Reviewed the budget to confirm the following was included: Building & Grounds increase to \$25,000, increase Animal Control to \$4,000 and added \$1,072.20 to Technology for the purchase of the Dell computer for CFO.
2. Continued discussion of hiring of Deputy Clerk: at this time there will be no hiring of a Deputy Clerk but instead possibly using an existing employee to cover for the office for vacations, sick time or any other reason the office would have to close. That employee would need to be appointed as office help and an amendment to the salary ordinance to pay that position. This line item will remain as is.
3. Employee salary increases: Mayor and the majority of Council decided not to give employee increases for 2021.
