

Message from Mayor concerning COVID-19

The Mayor and Town Council of Corbin City acknowledge the concerns and feelings of uncertainty that our residents may have regarding the Coronavirus , COVID-19.

We can assure all of our residents that we are working with Atlantic County and State partners to respond to this public health threat.

The CDC and the NJ Department of Health have provided the following ways that you can protect yourself and family members from contracting and spreading COVID-19.

- 1 Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Alcohol based hand sanitizer with a minimum of 60% alcohol content can also be used.
- 2 Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.
- 3 Avoid close contact with those who are sick.
- 4 Cough or sneeze into a tissue and throw it directly into the trash. Use sleeve or arm, do not sneeze into hands.
- 5 Clean and disinfect common household areas such as tables, chairs, light switches, doorknobs, remotes, handles, toilets and sinks.
- 6 Stay at home if you are sick.

This is a time for preparation, we ask that you do your part to help keep our town healthy. The safety of our residents is our priority.
